Festival hours are from 10 AM until 5 PM. If you want to be included in the Wakulla News special insert, please return your application **by Oct. 1**. *Selection of vendors is the unconditional right of the St. Marks Stone Crab Committee.*

1. **A reminder to vendors selling hot foods:** You are required by law to have a current State License. Any vendors not currently licensed through Dept. of Business and Professional Regulation will be required to obtain a temporary event food license. Or you may prefer to get a yearly license. You may contact DBPR at 850-487-1395 or on the internet at [Http://www.myflorida.com/dbpr/hr/forms/index.shtml#licensing](http://www.myflorida.com/dbpr/hr/forms/index.shtml#licensing)
2. **If you are selling just cold foods, such as lemonade, snow cones, or prepackaged foods** you must have a permit from the Department of Agriculture. Please have your paperwork in your possession in case of an inspection. You may contact the Division of Food Safety at 850-245-5520 or on the internet at [www.doacs.state.fl.us](http://www.doacs.state.fl.us) for more information.
3. **Non-Profit Food Vendors** need to have a copy of your current Florida Dept. of Revenue Consumer Certificate of Exemption as a non-profit organization. You are exempted from the above requirements.
4. **Booth numbers** will be assigned by the St. Marks Stone Crab Festival Vendor Coordinator. You will receive your assignment via mail or e-mail and one vendor parking pass for your vehicle in October.
5. You may begin **set up at 7:00 AM**. If you chose to set up the day before, please do so before 4PM. Items left over night will be at your own risk.
6. All vehicles must be removed from the festival grounds by **9:30 AM**.
7. You are responsible for your own ice, tent, tables and chairs. Bring tie downs for your tents.
8. Be prepared for the weather; rain, wind or sun. Bring bug spray, everything is outdoors.
9. For those of you who requested electricity; please bring a 100 foot-110 watt extension cord. We do not provide 220 plugs. No air conditioners are allowed. If you need more than one outlet, please let me know.
10. Vendors are responsible for maintaining constant booth cleanliness and must dispose of garbage in City provided cans.
11. Booths may be removed at **5 PM**. **Vehicles are not allowed on the festival grounds 9:30AM - 5 PM.**
12. All vendors are responsible for reporting state sales tax to the State Revenue Dept.
13. Fresh water may be obtained by filling your own buckets at a central water valve.
14. Booth wastewater and grease must be contained and disposed of properly.
15. For the safety of our visitors, no pets are allowed on festival grounds.

**Directions to St. Marks.** We are located at the end of Highway 363. From Tallahassee take S. Monroe Street, which turns into Woodville Highway, go approximately 20 miles south. Do not make the mistake of turning at Highway 98. Continue thru the caution light until you come into the town of St. Marks. The festival is located downtown next to Bo Lynn's Store. If you are coming from Panacea, head East on Highway 98 until you get to the intersection of Highway 363, turn right. If you are coming from Perry, head west on Highway 98 until you come to the intersection of Highway 363 and turn left to St. Marks. You can follow the signs for San Marcos de Apalache Fort.

We have limited the number of vendors. So please call as soon as possible if you are not able to attend, so that someone else may use your space.

The St. Marks Waterfronts and the St. Marks Stone Crab Festival volunteers have planned for an exceptional wonderful day. We appreciate you for joining us to celebrate the opening of the Stone Crab season and to support our town and organizations.
